Assumed Understanding

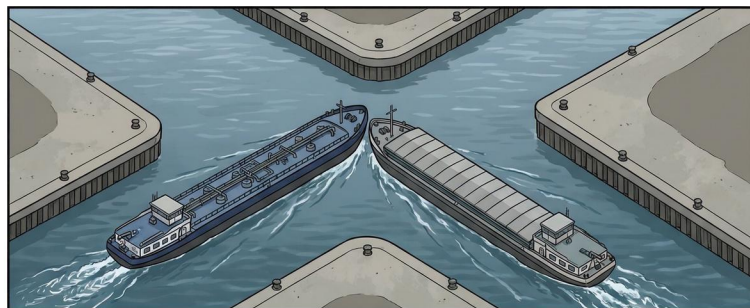
Without VHF confirmation, your message is just an assumption—always verify before maneuvering.



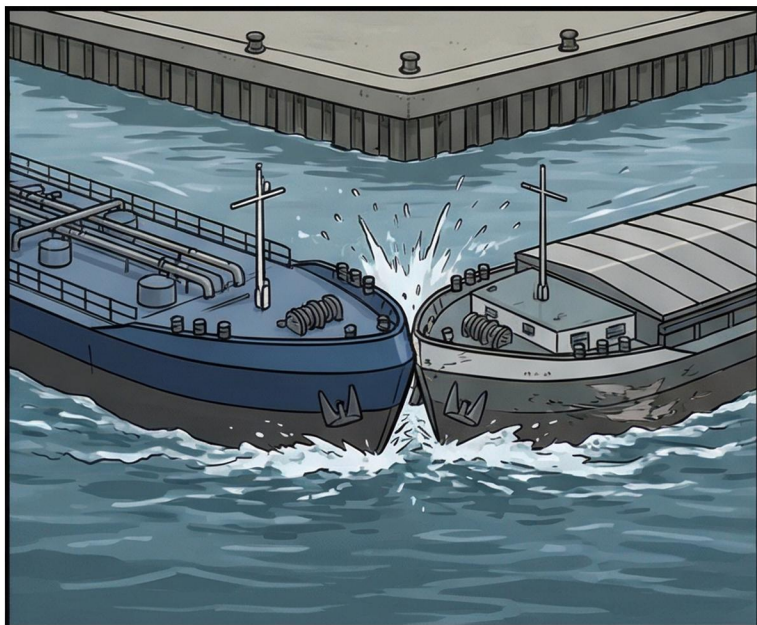
Captain Jansen approaches a harbor junction and radios a vessel he cannot yet see around the corner.



Aboard the other vessel, Helmsman De Vries hears the English message but does not fully understand it.



Both vessels round the corner and discover each other on collision course—too late to avoid impact.



The bows collide at the junction point—an accident that a simple confirmation could have prevented.



Always confirm receipt over VHF—assumptions on the water lead to collisions.
